

## **NICENE CREED**

## **PRAYER OF THE CHURCH**

*A venerable old tradition for the Prayer of the Church on All Saints is to use the prayers from the Funeral Rite, making adjustments for this feast day use. These are prayers that speak fully of the communion of saints and faith in the resurrection, all themes of the day.*

**A** On the day of All Saints', we remember with thanksgiving the members of our church who have died during this past year since last All Saints: Donald Bobb, Ronald Gregory, Joan Hinkle, Thelma Johnson, Ruth Norton, Jay Pezdirc, and Anne Richards. We pray that God would grant them eternal rest and that we would be kept in communion with all the saints until we are reunited with them around the heavenly throne of God and the Lamb.

Almighty God, you have knit your chosen people together in one communion, in the mystical body of your Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. Give to your whole Church in heaven and on earth your light and your peace. We pray...

**C** **Hear us, Lord.**

**A** Grant that all who have been baptized into Christ's death and resurrection may die to sin and rise to newness of life and that through the grave and gate of death we may pass with him to our joyful resurrection. We pray...

**C** **Hear us, Lord.**

**A** Grant to us who are still in our pilgrimage, and who walk as yet by faith, that your Holy Spirit may lead us in holiness and righteousness all our days. We pray...

**C** **Hear us, Lord.**

**A** Grant to your faithful people pardon and peace, that we may be cleansed from all our sins and serve you with a quiet mind. We pray...

**C** **Hear us, Lord.**

**A** Grant to all who mourn a sure confidence in your loving care, that, casting all their sorrow on you, they may know the consolation of your love. We pray...

**C** **Hear us, Lord.**

**A** Give courage and faith to those who are bereaved, that they may have strength to meet the days ahead in the comfort of a holy and certain hope, and in the joyful expectation of eternal life with those they love. We pray...

**C** **Hear us, Lord.**

**A** Give your healing help to all who are sick or in any need. Especially we pray for: ... Help us, we pray, in the midst of things we cannot understand, to believe and trust in the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, and the resurrection to life everlasting. We pray...

**C** **Hear us, Lord.**

**P** O God, the generations rise and pass away before you. You are the strength of those who labor; you are the rest of the blessed dead. We rejoice in the company of your saints. We remember all who have lived in faith, all who have peacefully died, and especially those most dear to us who rest in you, whose names we remember before you now. *(People may offer names of friends or relatives who have died.)* Give us in time our portion with those who have trusted in you and have striven to do your holy will. To your name, with the Church on earth and the Church in heaven, we ascribe all honor and glory, now and forever.




